ORDER AND JUDGMENT

THIS MATTER being opened to the Court by Paul G. Nittoly, Esq. of Drinker, Biddle & Reath, LLP and Joseph B. Tiboni, Esq. of Tiboni & Tiboni, L.L.P., Attorneys for the Petitioner. F.S.; and with Donald D. Vanarelli, Esq. of the Law Offices of Donald D. Vanarelli, appearing as Attorney for the alleged incapacitated person. T.S.; and the Court having reviewed the Report and Certifications of Services of Christopher D. Armstrong, Esq., Court Appointed Guardian *Ad Litem*, together with the reports of the physicians submitted on behalf of the parties; and the Court having heard the testimony of witnesses given in this matter regarding the capacity of T.S., an alleged incapacitated person; and the Court having issued a written decision dated 11 May 2010 in this matter; and the Court being satisfied that there is good and sufficient cause for the entry of this Order and Judgment.

IT IS THEREFORE on this 8th day of July, 2010, ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that:

1. The Complaint of the Petitioner. F.S., for appointment of a Guardian for T.S., is denied;
2. T.S. shall pay the amount of \$ 9,000 to Christopher D. Armstrong, Esq., Guardian Ad Litem, for legal fees and costs related to this matter within fifteen (15) days of the entry of this Order;
3. F.S. shall pay the amount of \$ 9,000 to Christopher D. Armstrong, Esq., Guardian Ad Litem, for legal fees and costs related to this matter within fifteen (15) days of the entry of this Order;
4. Christopher D. Armstrong, Esq., is hereby discharged as Court Appointed Guardian *Ad Litem* for T.S., with the appreciation of the Court; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that a copy of this Order and Judgment be served upon all counsel in this matter within 7 days from the entry of this Order.
